Peak – Residential Delivery Charge

Customers at the enterprise level who meet a certain volume threshold (as indicated below) will be charged a Peak – Residential Delivery Charge for packages shipped during Nov. 2, 2020–Jan. 17, 2021. The scope of a customer's volume shall be determined by FedEx in its sole discretion. The Peak – Residential Delivery Charge will be assessed in addition to the customer's Residential Delivery Charge. Any contracted discount the customer may have on the Residential Delivery Charge will not apply to the Peak – Residential Delivery Charge. For invoicing purposes, this charge will be combined with the customer's Residential Delivery Charge.

- For customers who ship more than 35,000 weekly average packages (total for FedEx Express and FedEx Ground U.S. domestic residential and commercial combined) from Oct. 5, 2020–Oct. 18, 2020, the Peak – Residential Delivery Charge reflected in the Peaking Factor chart will apply Nov. 2, 2020–Dec. 13, 2020. The amount charged per package will be based on a Peaking Factor, calculated as weekly average packages shipped Oct. 5, 2020–Oct. 18, 2020, divided by weekly average packages shipped Feb. 3, 2020–March 1, 2020, multiplied by 100. Peaking Factor and amount charged are determined separately for FedEx Express and FedEx Ground.
- For customers who ship more than 35,000 weekly average packages (total for FedEx Express and FedEx Ground U.S. domestic residential and commercial combined) from Nov. 16, 2020–Nov. 29, 2020*, the Peak – Residential Delivery Charge reflected in the Peaking Factor chart will apply Dec. 14, 2020–Jan. 17, 2021. The amount charged per package will be based on a Peaking Factor, calculated as weekly average packages shipped Nov. 16, 2020–Nov. 29, 2020,* divided by weekly average packages shipped Feb. 3, 2020–March 1, 2020, multiplied by 100. Peaking Factor and amount charged are determined separately for FedEx Express and FedEx Ground.

**For weeks with holidays, weekly average value will be prorated based on the FedEx normal operating days during non-holiday weeks.*

- Customers who qualify for the Peak – Residential Delivery Charge will be notified of their peaking factor prior to the effective date. For customers whose peak volume exceeds 35,000 and who have a Peaking Factor greater than 200%, a peak volume and fee schedule must be negotiated and signed.

⁴ Peak Surcharge applies to all packages in any weekly invoice period exceeding 110% of the customer's average weekly volume for the applicable service level for February (February 2 through February 29, 2020), as determined by UPS in its sole and unlimited discretion. For holiday weeks that are not full UPS operating weeks (Including Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's), the surcharge will apply to all packages in that weekly invoice period exceeding 110% of the customer's average daily volume for the applicable service level for February (February 2 through February 29, 2020) multiplied by the number of full UPS operating days in that week, as determined by UPS in its sole and unlimited discretion. If customer's average weekly volume for the applicable service level for September (August 30 through October 3, 2020) is less than 80% of its average weekly volume for February (February 2 through February 29, 2020), as determined by UPS in its sole and unlimited discretion, then for the remainder of the Peak Period the Peak Surcharge for that service level will apply to all packages in any weekly invoice period exceeding 110% of the customer's average weekly volume for September. Customer's volume includes any affiliated accounts and other accounts related to customer, as determined by UPS in its sole and unlimited discretion.

⁵ Applies to customer's who (1) ship more than 1,000 total packages in any week during the Peak Period, or (2) ship more than 10 packages combined that are Large Packages, Over Maximum Limits. or require Additional Handling in any week during the Peak Period. Once this threshold has been met, the Peak Surcharges apply for the remainder of the Peak Period to all Large Packages, packages that are Over Maximum Limits, and packages that require Additional Handling.
